

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Firebrand is a water-conditioning agent to ameliorate the hardness of water. When sprayed, it conditions the leaves of glyphosate susceptible broad-leaved and grass weeds and thus predisposes the weeds to full and rapid uptake of glyphosate, thereby permitting high efficacy.

RATE OF USE

Use Firebrand at 0.5% v/v in the spray solution.

MIXING

Add the required quantity of Firebrand to the sprayer tank half filled with water and with the re-circulation system in action. Top up the tank to the required level with water. Maintain re-circulation until the tank is sprayed out. Spray immediately after mixing.

When tank-mixing Firebrand, the Directions for Use of any products mixed must be strictly observed. Mix Firebrand in the spray tank before adding another product. Spray immediately after mixing.

CARE OF SPRAYER

After each days use, wash out the sprayer thoroughly with water and a recognised cleaning agent.
