DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is a penetrative surfactant designed to improve the retention and uptake of pesticides and to reduce variability of pesticide performance under adverse conditions.

USE

This product is authorised for use:

In winter and spring cereals:

- for use with all approved herbicides and tank-mixtures containing such products applied at full or reduced rate and approved timings;
- for use with all approved fungicides, plant growth regulators and insecticides applied at full rate upto and including GS 52 (1/4 inflorescence), and at half the approved rate thereafter.

In other crops:

- for use with all approved pesticides applied at full rate upto and including the following crop growth stages, and with all approved pesticides applied at half the approved pesticide rate thereafter:

Crop	Applied at or before the following crop growth stages:
Beans	up to and including first pod set (EPPO code 204)
Potatoes	up to and including tuber initiation
Linseed	up to and including 10% capsules formed (code 51, Freer 1991)
Maize	up to and including tip of tassel visible (EPPO code 53)
Oilseed rape	up to and including 10% potential pods (code 5.1, Sylvester-Bradley, 1985)
Edible podded peas	up to and including pod set (EPPO code 204)
Sugar beet	up to and including 6 fully expanded leaves (EPPO code 23)

- for use with approved pesticides to control bracken in forestry situations and on managed amenity turf;
- this product also has authorisation for use with all approved pesticides applied at half the approved pesticide rate in all crop and non-crop situations.

For specific recommendations consult Interagro or its agents.

RATES OF USE

This product should be used at a rate to give a 0.15% dilution of the final spray volume. For example 300ml of product in 200 litres of water per hectare.

MIXING

Half fill the spray tank with clean water and commence agitation. Add the recommended quantity of this product. Then add the recommended quantity of pesticide and the remaining balance of water whilst maintaining agitation throughout. If foaming occurs, add the required quantity of Abate to remove foam.

PRECAUTIONS
